School Bus Aide Charged with Sexual Assaults of Students

County Attorney Pete Orput today announced the filing of charges against Harvey Kneifl, age 70, of Woodbury. Kneifl was charged with 6 counts of 2nd Degree Sexual Assault. He will have his first appearance tomorrow.

According to the complaint filed in the case, Kneifl is a school bus attendant assisting children on the bus with special needs for the South Washington County School District on routes in Woodbury. After an investigation by the Woodbury Police Department, with the cooperation of the school district, Kneifl is seen on video from inside the bus on two occasions, touching 6 children under age 13 on their genitals over their clothing. At least 3 of the children confirmed to law enforcement that which was readily visible on the school district's video of the bus interior.

Orput stated, "The first duty of this office is the protection of our children. What this defendant is alleged to have done is totally abhorrent to society. The case will be prosecuted with that standard in mind."

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The Complainant states that the following facts establish probable cause:
Your Complainant is a licensed Minnesota peace officer with the Woodbury Police Department. Complainant offers the following statement to establish probable cause:
On February 4, 2017 at approximately 8:20 p.m., Officer Ryan Schroeder of the Woodbury Police Department was contacted by the father of who reported that his daughter takes the bus to school in the South Washington County School District. On this bus route there is a driver and a school bus attendant/aid to assist children because some of the children have special needs. On February 3, 2017, took the bus and noticed that the normal bus attendant/aid was not on the bus. The new bus attendant was identified as Harvey Theodore Kneifl, herein known as Defendant, DOB 6/25/1946. When sat down on the bus the Defendant sat next to her and first then rubbed leg. After rubbing her leg the Defendant then proceeded to rub the child's genital area in a rough manner "four or five" times. reported to her parents that she was scared by the Defendant's actions. The route of this bus always travels in Washington County.
After taking the initial report, your Complainant was assigned to the case for further investigation. Investigator Miller made contact with the bus company director Carrie Olson. Ms. Olson had been made aware of the assault. The bus company is South Washington Transportation Company (SWTC). Upon learning of the assault the bus company began working with law enforcement providing information on all children who were on that route, identification of the bus driver, the identity of the Defendant and video from the bus taken on February 3, 2017. SWTC reported that this is a bus route for pre-K and special needs children. The Defendant duties were to aid children who got on the bus and make sure that they were traveling safe. When the Complainant reviewed the video the Defendant is seen touching the genital area of multiple girls in a sexual manner over their clothing.
After SWTC was made aware of the Defendant's actions they obtained video from a bus dated January 27, 2017. The Defendant w as the bus attendant/aid on that bus route. The bus route was the same route as mentioned above. In that video, the Defendant is seen touching female children in the same aggressive sexual manner. On January 27, 2017, the children sexually assaulted by the Defendant were identified as and
A review of the video from February 3, 2017 identify and as victims of sexual assault by the Defendant. In the video the Defendant is seen touching these children over their clothing in their genital area in a sexual manner.
All parents of the children were immediately notified and three children were seen at Midwest Children's Resource Center (MCRC) by a physician. The following children were interviewed and examined: and All three children disclosed that the Defendant would touch and rub their genital area with his hands.

On February 8, 2017 the Defendant was interviewed after being read his Miranda Rights. He agreed to speak with law enforcement officers. During that interview the Defendant confirmed that he was on the above mentioned bus routes. He admitted that he likes to tickle, poke and hug the children, that he puts his hands on the girls thighs rubbing them. He denied rubbing any of the genital areas, claiming he makes the girls feel good because "they come from a hard life and likely do not get any sort of affection at home', he believes he becomes closer to the children than their parents, and he likes sitting by the girls on this bus because they are "more fun".

Defendant was subsequently arrested and transported to the Washington County Jail.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or

(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
