

Executive Summary McGuire Timeline

- The Jesuits received sufficient notice about serious issues regarding McGuire in **1962** when it was reported directly to the Chicago Provincial by Superiors in Munich, Germany that McGuire had engaged in suspicious behavior with minor boys and again in **1964** when concerns from Superiors in Austria about McGuire's behaviors with young boys (including an extended trip with a boy to Ireland resulting in a police investigation) was brought to their attention.
- Since **1969**, when the Jesuits learned that McGuire had sexually abused a 15 year old boy, there have been at least **28** reports to the Jesuits of inappropriate and abusive sexual behavior by McGuire with young adolescent boys.
- From **1962-2007**, the Jesuits received over **30** discrete opportunities to protect children.
 - Reports were made directly to the Jesuits about concerns of McGuire's behaviors - such reports included eye witness accounts of young males sleeping/living in the same room with McGuire, McGuire traveling with young male assistants, reports of McGuire taking showers with young males, reading pornography with young males, having young males give McGuire massages, and reports of him and young boys masturbating in front of each other.
 - Despite these reports, McGuire remained in ministry and was not defrocked until **2008, 2 years after he was criminally convicted of sexual abuse of two minors in Wisconsin.**
- In spite of McGuire's 6 month commitment at St. John Vianney Hospital and subsequent diagnoses of a sexual behavior disorder in January **1994**, McGuire was allowed to continue an unsupervised retreat schedule around the world in which he traveled with and was around young males. Complaints to the Jesuits concerning McGuire continued after his release from St. John's and at least **8** boys were abused by McGuire after his release.
- The Jesuits imposed 5 sets of guidelines on McGuire. The Jesuits knew McGuire ignored the guidelines and continued to have inappropriate contact with young males, but did nothing to stop him. The Jesuits relied on McGuire to self monitor.

- The Jesuits give McGuire a Canonical warning in 2002, but allow him to continue as a Jesuit in "good standing."
- After McGuire is charged with sexual abuse of 2 minors in Wisconsin in 2004, the Jesuits refuse to cooperate with authorities and misrepresent what they knew about McGuire's long history of inappropriate sexual conduct.
- The Jesuits allow McGuire to wear his clerical garb during his entire Wisconsin trial and in violation of the Dallas Charter.
- McGuire is convicted in Wisconsin on five counts of sexual assault of two minors in 2006
- McGuire indicted in Federal court in Chicago in 2007 for abusing another minor.
- McGuire finally defrocked in February 2008

- McGuire indicted in Arizona in April 2008 for abusing 2 more minors.
- McGuire convicted in Federal court and sentenced to 25 years in prison in 2009.
