



PARTIAL TIMELINE OF MICHAEL W WEBER

1944: DOB 6/25/1944

1962: Graduate of Crosier Seminary High School (Onamia, MN)

1963-1968: Camp Counselor at Camp Foley in Pine River, MN

1966: BA from St. John's University (Collegeville, Minn.)

1967: Michael Weber became a "big brother" to John Doe #1 who was then 12 years old (born 04/07/1955).

1967 – 1970: “St. Cloud Diocesan Seminarian” at Saint John’s School of Theology scheduled to graduate from SOT in May of 1970; did not graduate

1968: Weber sexually abused John Doe #1 on at least one occasion, including an incident at Webers' parent’s home in Foley, MN following a Minnesota North Stars’ game.

1968: Weber began to abuse John Doe #1's ten-year-old cousin, John Doe #2 (born 08/01/1957).

1969 – 1970: John Doe #1 reported Weber's misconduct to his school counselor, Mr. Haire. The school counselor referred John Doe #1 (and his mother) to Mr. Jim Graeve, a counselor with Caritas Family Services. Caritas was, and remains today, a division of Catholic Charities, a division of the St. Cloud Diocese.

1969 – 1970: Ordained a Transitional Deacon with the St. Cloud Diocese; expected 1970 ordination with the St. Cloud Diocese

1970: Abused John Doe HT near Alexandria, MN

1972: MA from the U of Chicago School of Social Service Administration

1972: Still a deacon with the St. Cloud Diocese, Weber petitions the Vatican for, and is granted, laicization.

2001: St. Cloud Diocese sends Victim #2 a letter following a meeting at the Diocesan office.

2009: St. Cloud Diocese files a report with the St. Cloud Police Department

2010: Unknown victim called Volunteers of America – Minnesota board member about Weber. Weber resigned his position as CEO of the Volunteers of America Board of Directors
