

Some time ago you agreed that a change should be made here and said that reasons would have to be given. If a change comes as a surprise to Father Coughlin, it is because my attitude has continued to be friendly and, for the most part, patient even when deeply disturbed over things that were not right.

Underlying our problem is, perhaps a lack of communication. I have not been able to impress him with the importance of cooperating with me in the work most needed in the parish. For example, he prefers to spend a lot of time with nonessentials in our school, including a boy's choral group and coaching the teams. On the other hand, he has to be asked repeatedly to visit C.C.D. classes or some of our thirty five released time groups. He will not take a day off but usually takes off in the afternoon for sports and other activities with our boys or affairs of a personal nature.

Father Coughlin brings from the East the attitude that he is available for people who arrange to see him but he prefers not to make calls. I keep him busy with our many marriage arrangements and instructions. When not busy, he is gone. On the credit side, I must say that he is always willing to see people when they ask him. He is good about taking weddings, funerals and a second or third Mass when needed. He is friendly and cheerful. Perhaps another pastor will be able to work with him better than I. It should also be noted that during the first six months he was here from Boston, he had very little supervision. He became set in his routine and was not able to adjust to my administration.

Our 2,000 families need an assistant who will do a day's work and be able to assume responsibility. (It will need two when this administrator gets further along in his sixties and starts to slow down.)





Your Excellency:

Rev. Richard T. Coughlin has written to REDACTED REDACTED REDACTED requesting to be incardinated in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. Father Coughlin is a priest of the Archdiocese of Boston who now serves in Los Angeles on a "lend lease" basis.

REDACTED is inclined to grant this request, but before doing so, he wishes to be assured of your full approval.

A second matter of concern to REDACTED is the fact that although Father Coughlin is a member of the Clergy Fund Society of the Archdiocese of Boston and thus has been protected from the burden of medical and hospitalization expenses, to date he is \$400.00 in arrears in payment of his yearly assessments. The Clergy Fund is facing staggering financial demands and will only be able to fulfill its obligations if each priest pays his personal assessment. REDACTED Would request Father Coughlin to meet this financial obligation to the Archdiocese of Boston before acting on his request.





On 111299 at approximately 2005 hours, I spoke with victim ^{REDACTED} on the phone. The conversation was tape-recorded; following is a synopsis.

REDACTED joined the chorus in 1969, when he was an 11-year old 5th-grader at St. Anthony Claret Catholic Church/School, Anaheim. REDACTED was a charter member of the chorus, which began as a barbershop choir. Initially, the choir was a class elective and as such, attracted boys whose musical abilities and true dedication were questionable. Coughlin decided to reconstitute the choir by personally auditioning and selecting boys who possessed musical talent and a real interest in participating. REDACTED; best friend, REDACTED was selected and asked REDACTED to also join.

Practices were held at the church after school, so Coughlin never took REDACTED to or from practice. The chorus performed locally at convalescent homes, women's clubs, Elks Clubs, etc. REDACTED went on two European tours in 1971 and 1972.

^{REDACTED} estimated that he was in the choir approximately one year before Coughlin sexually molested him. ^{REDACTED} could not recall where this occurred or which specific act occurred first. ^{REDACTED} estimated that he was in the choir for five years and that the last molestation incident occurred when he was in 8th grade. ^{REDACTED} explained that in 8th grade, he joined the baseball team and his voice changed. ^{REDACTED} quit the choir just prior to their U.S. tour that year, but was asked to stay on as a tour assistant. ^{REDACTED} served in that capacity until June 1973. He estimated that he had the last sexual contact with Coughlin around April/May 1973.

REDACTED was reluctant to speak with me for a variety of personal reasons. Further, he had great difficulty discussing the specifics of Coughlin's abuse when I asked what form the sexual contact took. I asked REDACTED if there were any acts of sodomy or oral copulation and he said no. REDACTED was never asked to touch Coughlin's genitals. REDACTED recalled five to ten incidents where Coughlin touched REDACTED 's genitals. Some of these incidents took place in the shower.

REDACTED described sexual molestations that took place in San Clemente and San Diego hotel rooms, as well as at Coughlin's^{REDACTED}'s house. REDACTED told me that Coughlin "had favorites who he obviously liked" and took small groups on trips. On occasion, REDACTED roomed with Coughlin. REDACTED thought that they stayed at the Town and Country Resort in San Diego three or four times. A couple of times, they went to (possibly) the San Clemente Inn. REDACTED recalled that the facility was near what was, at the time, President Richard Nixon's Western White House. Coughlin's REDACTED had a tri-level home, and the choir often went there as a group. REDACTED was there alone one time with Coughlin.

I asked ^{REDACTED} to describe the sexual touching in San Diego. ^{REDACTED} told me, "He had this thing for washing me." While Coughlin remained dressed, he accompanied ^{REDACTED} into the shower. ^{REDACTED} was not circumcised and Coughlin told him that he was going to teach him how to keep himself clean. Coughlin explained that ^{REDACTED} needed to be "extra careful" about his hygiene. I asked ^{REDACTED} if Coughlin just explained what to do or actually demonstrated on ^{REDACTED} He said that Coughlin actually washed his penis. ^{REDACTED} recalled that Coughlin also did this when they were in Austria on tour.

REDACTED then recounted what happened at Coughlin's REDACTED's house. First, REDACTED had a vague memory of Coughlin helping him dress in an outside dressing area. He did not remember any specific sexual touching that may have occurred. REDACTED did recall a sexual encounter in Coughlin's REDACTED's room. The two were alone and Coughlin kissed him on the mouth. As Coughlin kissed him, Coughlin touched REDACTED's penis. He could not remember if it was over or under his clothing. This act did not last long for two reasons. REDACTED told Coughlin that "I had to go to the bathroom bad." Next, REDACTED had recently seen an episode of Gilligan's Island. In it, Ginger and Maryanne ate something that acted as an aphrodisiac. They wanted to kiss the Professor, who was much too straitlaced. The Professor explained that kissing would not be a good idea because it transferred germs. REDACTED said that he told Coughlin the

same thing. REDACTED was sitting down as Coughlin kissed and fondled him.

Regarding the incidents in San Clemente, ^{REDACTED} remembered being washed in the shower, as in San Diego. ^{REDACTED} did not remember ever being taken to an Orange County motel, saying that there would not have been any reason to do that. By the same token, he could not recall any sexual molestation occurring on or in a motel bed.

REDACTED never confronted Coughlin about his actions and essentially put the incidents behind him. Eight or 9 years ago, victim called REDACTED called REDACTED explaining that he was trying to pursue Coughlin for molesting him. "Went public," but REDACTED "wanted to go on with my life" and did not want to get involved. Until I spoke with REDACTED, he had never disclosed Coughlin's sexual abuse.

REDACTED did say that a friend, REDACTED, had a REDACTED, REDACTED, REDACTED that Coughlin "tried to do something" to REDACTED and "he bailed on the chorus." REDACTED could provide no further details.

My client confirms the testimony taken by the Police Department as being true and correct, but would add that on occasion, the Bishop would not only touch his penis, but would fondle his penis.

The actions imposed upon my client by the Roman Catholic Church through the actions of Bishop Coughlin has seriously damaged my client and will remain so the rest of his life. On behalf of my client, I am asking the church to consider negotiating for a payment of damages of a reasonable amount to compenstate REDACTED for the reprehensible conduct of Bishop Coughlin toward my client as outlined in this statement taken by the Placentia Police Department.

My client, REDACTED falls within the Code of Civil Procedure, Section 340.1, which allows him to proceed with a complaint against the church, in that he has most recently discovered the psychological injuries that occurred from the sexual abuse of Bishop Coughlin during the period of time he owed Mr. REDACTED the duty of care.
