

Martin Ronald Koski

Martin Ronald Koski was an assistant scoutmaster with Troop 293 in Minnewashta, MN in 1976. In December 1976 he pleaded guilty to raping an 11-year-old boy from his Troop in Minneapolis when the Boy Scout helped him move furniture into his apartment. He was sentenced to one year in a work release program for the attack. Koski was placed in the [Confidential](#) Files and resigned from the Boy Scouts of America in November 1976 following the incident of sexual abuse. He is believed to have died in 1992.
