

Robert Messersmith

Robert Messersmith was born in 1942. He was affiliated with the Boy Scouts of America in a leadership position with the Boy Scout Explorers Post No. 3 in St. Cloud, Minnesota.

Prior to joining the Boy Scouts in St. Cloud, Messersmith was convicted of sexually assaulting teenage boys in New Hampshire, where he worked for the Salem Boys Club. Messersmith later moved to Minnesota with his family and was in a leadership position with the Boy Scouts in the 1980s. In 1989, Messersmith was charged with five counts of using minors in a sexual performance and suspended from registration with the Boy Scouts of America. Messersmith was added to the [Boy Scouts' Ineligible Volunteer files](#) in 1989.
