Dear Mr. Blacker:

I am writing to you to express my concern about the leadership of the local Boy Scout troop (#829) in Pulaski, N.Y. Are you aware that the current scoutmaster, Salvatore Filicia, was arrested for and convicted of sexual abuse of his stepdaughter within the past year? I am contacting you, instead of locally involved adults because it's hard for me to believe that in a small community like this, they were not aware of this situation when they reportedly sought him out for this job recently.


Professionals estimate that $\frac{1}{2}$ of all girls and 1/10-1/7 of all boys are sexually abused before reaching age 18. It is also known that the same adult may victimize both male and female children. Additionally, this type of behavior is very resistant to change, by treatment or willpower. Repeat offenders are frequently in the headlines.

Besides putting a number of youths at risk of abuse, this situation is also a setup for an individual who has been determined to have this problem. Also, he cannot be considered as a positive role model for the boys, being a convicted sex offender and probationer.

I strongly urge his removal from this position immediately. You can verify the facts of the criminal matter with the New York State Police and the Oswego County Probation Department. I intend to follow-up on this and will take further, more public, action if this situation is allowed to continue.
