

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND MUTUAL RELEASE

This Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release (hereafter "Agreement") is made by and between [REDACTED]; St. John's School for the Deaf and its affiliated and successor corporations (hereafter "St. John's"); and the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Milwaukee (hereafter "Archdiocese"), and all of its affiliated entities.


WHEREAS, [REDACTED], and her son, [REDACTED], both allege certain claims against Fr. Lawrence Murphy (deceased), the Archdiocese, and St. John's, arising from alleged sexual abuse of [REDACTED] by Lawrence Murphy commencing in or about the 1960's and continuing for a number of years thereafter; and

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] further allege that the Archdiocese and St. John's may be liable for the actions of Lawrence Murphy that give rise to the alleged claims; and

WHEREAS, St. John's, and the Archdiocese deny liability for the claims, and there is a dispute between the parties; and

WHEREAS, the parties to this Agreement wish to settle and compromise all claims of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] against Lawrence Murphy, St. John's, the Roman Catholic

Archdiocese of Milwaukee, and all of St. John's and the Archdiocese's employees, agents, officers, directors and assigns, including, without limitation, all members of the Roman Catholic clergy and all parishes and religious orders, and any person or entity affiliated with the Roman Catholic Church in the territory of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, arising from the alleged abuse of [REDACTED] by Lawrence Murphy without the necessity of formal litigation and expense, and all parties wish to generally release one another from all liability for any claims that may exist to the date of the signing of this Agreement, including, but not limited to, any claims for sexual contact or abuse of any nature between Lawrence Murphy and [REDACTED];

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises herein provided and other valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties to this Agreement hereby agree as follows:

1. St. John's and the Archdiocese jointly agree to pay to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] the total sum of \$3,000, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. All parties will bear their own costs and attorneys' fees associated with this settlement. The above payment will be made by check jointly payable to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

2. In return for the payment in paragraph 1 above, and for the mutual promises contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] agree to release and forever discharge the estate of Lawrence Murphy, St. John's, and the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Milwaukee, and all of St. John's and the Archdiocese's employees, agents, officers, directors and assigns, including, without limitation, all members of the Roman Catholic clergy, and all parishes, schools, and religious orders, and any person or entity affiliated with the Roman Catholic Church in the territory of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee from, and covenants not to sue them for, all claims, causes of action, charges, and demands, whether in tort, contract, or otherwise, of any nature that they may have had at any time up to and including the date of signing of this Settlement Agreement, including without limitation any claim of any nature arising from any assault, injury, whether physical or mental, or any other activity by Lawrence Murphy.

3. St. John's and the Archdiocese hereby release and forever discharge [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] from all claims, demands, and causes of action of any nature that were in existence up to and including the date of the signing of this Agreement.

4. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] agree that they will not reveal to anyone, other than as may be mutually agreed to in writing, any of the specific terms of this agreement or any of the amounts, numbers or terms and conditions of any sums payable to them hereunder. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] hereby understand and agree that this confidentiality section of the Agreement is of paramount importance and that observance of this confidentiality section is of the essence to the agreement achieved between the parties. They agree to abide by the terms of this confidentiality section as consideration for and as an integral part of the Agreement.

5. As a condition precedent to the payment of the sum set out in paragraph 1, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] hereby agrees not to disclose to any third-party, including, without limitation, any newspaper, any electronic media, any reporters, and any other individual, or to release for publicity any of the allegations which have been made against Lawrence Murphy, St. John's, and the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, or the terms of this Agreement. The terms of this Agreement relating to confidentiality do not apply to any disclosures made to [REDACTED] therapist, support person (as that term is used in AODA treatment) or close friends or relatives. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] understand and agree that

the confidentiality required in this Agreement is a material consideration for the payments to be made pursuant to this Agreement.

6. The parties agree that this Agreement is not an admission of liability on the part of any party.

7. [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] DECLARE THAT THEY HAVE READ THE FOREGOING AGREEMENT, AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS. [REDACTED] FURTHER DECLARES THAT HE HAS OBTAINED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING FOR THE INJURIES ALLEGED AND UNDERSTANDS THEIR IMPACT ON HIM; AND DECLARES THAT HE VOLUNTARILY ACCEPTS THE TERMS AND SUM OF MONEY UNDER THIS AGREEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING A FULL AND FINAL COMPROMISE, ADJUSTMENT AND SETTLEMENT OF ALL CLAIMS AS DESCRIBED ABOVE.



I spoke with Paul Tiffin, an Assistant District Attorney. He informed me that his office sees the possibility of a charge filed against Fr. Marv Knighton by [REDACTED]. He said that the next step for him would be to turn it over to the Wauwatosa Police Department to investigate. He assured me that they would let us know if any charge is filed. He understands the importance of us managing disclosure on that. In his opinion it is not necessary for us to continue to press Fr. Marv Knighton for a Child Protective Service investigation, seeing that we have no reason to suspect any abuse of his son.


Dear Mr. McCann,

Per our conversation yesterday, I am sending you copies of two recent reports I took of allegations of sexual abuse against minors by Fr. Marv Knighton, for your consideration and investigation. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are aware I am taking this action, and are supportive.


Fr. Marv Knighton does not know of this action, per our protocols, so that your office may first make him aware of it. However Fr. Joe Hornacek and I have discussed the allegations with Fr. Marv Knighton (and he has denied them), because we previously interpreted these allegations as falling within our protocol for allegations outside of statute of limitations. I sincerely apologize for any mistake we made in this regard. Fr. Marv Knighton was notified on April 2, 2002 that he has been removed from any form of ministry in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee.

I now understand from you that you are interested in any abuse of minors occurring since July 1, 1989. I can assure that we have recently reviewed all of our files and have no other reported incidents since that date.




**Entry for the File of Father Jerry Wagner

I had an emotional phone call from [REDACTED] in Fond du Lac. She was clearly upset about the damage to a Church she loves. She was calling to register concerns about Jerry Wagner, even though she recognizes she has no specific information to result in any action. She is now a retired child protective services worker. While she was still a worker, a captain of the Fond du Lac Police Department told her in frustration about children that were claming up and denying inappropriate behavior by Fr. Wagner. She has been concerned about the young boys that she has seen coming and going from the rectory. Apparently a few weeks ago, an acquaintance of hers also had concerns, but when this other woman talked to the family of a child, they reportedly told her they wanted nothing to do with making a report.





A Hispanic woman had recently told Sr. Consuela that a local priest had abused her husband when he was a child. Sr. Consuela does not know the name of the victim or the offender, although there is suggestion that it maybe Fr. S. Widera. Nevertheless, she is concerned about her duty to report. I explained to her that there is no duty to report in this instance, and encouraged passing on information to this man about how Project Benjamin maybe able to serve him. Sr. Consuela will be leaving Wisconsin at the end of June to return to South Dakota.

Dear Dr Reinke,

Approximately ten years ago this coming December, I was accused of sexual "impropriety"; my case went to court three times and each time it was dismissed. I have been in clerical limbo since. With the recent disclosures of multiple cover-ups especially of the Archbishop and my first pastor, Rev Edmund Haen, I requested laicization. Before I leave the ministry, I must, however, "clear the air" and reveal to your office what I do know as fact and what I saw. For the last time, I unequivocally and categorically deny any sexual abuse or impropriety on my part; however, I did witness such activity. I have never reported any of this because no one ever asked me. I take it that was what was asked for at Dallas and, hence, this letter. There was always a "grapevine" with reports of priests by priests of what each other was doing almost as though this were a "rite of passage" but like many of us I disregarded this all as "hearsay"; like many I wanted no association with anything that remotely looked like deviancy or perversion. And then the following happened:






With this note I bring closure to the whole sick mess that is part and parcel of ministerial life in the Roman Catholic Church as I experienced it. The Dallas Declaration is proof for me of how sick the leadership was, is, and continues to be with regard to abuse. The lack of honesty and integrity at the highest levels in the Milwaukee Archdiocese is equally appalling. While some decry the criminality of sexual abuse of minors, the same clergy have for years broken their sacred vows and continue to live in the illusion that those sins can be concealed forever. Some of [REDACTED] public remarks were directly slated toward priests. Case in point, the Spring Clergy Assembly, May 1993. [REDACTED]

Do what you want with this information but please do me the favor of never contacting me for any reason. This is just another step in bringing my clerical life to a close. All of what I have relayed to you is well known by many, many priests, but they all have so much to loose! I've lost my mom, name, reputation, parish, ministry, and most benefits! These past almost 10 years have been agonizing but as more and more is brought to light with regard to what's happened and continues to happen here, it will become so good to see the hypocrites and liars fall from their high places to re-discover the true meaning of honesty and integrity!



INVESTIGATION PROCESS:

Father Hanser became friends with the family and subsequently invited the male children in the family to his lake cottage where the assaults took place.
