Fr. Donald McGuire Timeline

1961:	Fr. McGuire ordained a Jesuit priest
1962: Report #1	Letter to Jesuits about Fr. McGuire's suspicious behavior with minor boys.
1964: Report #2_	Report to Jesuits that Fr. McGuire had "much relations" with several boys and police in Ireland investigated.
1969: Report #3	Archdiocese of Chicago priest reports sexual abuse of minor John Doe 84 to the Jesuits.
1970-1975:	Fr. McGuire is "on sabbatical" finishing doctoral work at Loyola University
1970-1976:	Fr. McGuire meets Bobby Goldberg, age 12; Bobby endures repeated sexual abuse as a minor, almost daily.
1976:	Jesuits give Fr. McGuire permission to teach at the University of San Francisco.
1981: Report #4	Fr. McGuire's highly questionable acts and interactions with a student are reported to Jesuits. Fr. McGuire is told he needed serious psychological evaluation and therapy.
1984:	Fr. McGuire is working in Southern California.
1984:	In November, Archdiocese of Los Angeles Bishop removes Fr. McGuire from ministry and demands Fr. McGuire leave the Archdiocese.
1985	Fr. McGuire returns to Chicago.
1991: Report #5	Official at Retreat House reports to Jesuits that Fr. McGuire is traveling with a minor boy and sleeping in the same room as him, and also reports other suspicious behavior with the minor boy.
1991:	Jesuits tell Fr. McGuire not to travel on overnight trips with minors, but do not tell the public about the "restriction."
1993: Report #6	Jesuits are informed that Fr. McGuire is traveling with and sexually abusing a minor child.
1993:	Jesuits again tell Fr. McGuire not to travel overnight with any minors, but again do not tell the public about this "restriction."
1993:	Fr. McGuire is sent to St. John Vianney Hospital in Pennsylvania, which is known to specialize in housing priests accused of sexual problems. Fr. McGuire is diagnosed with sexual behavior disorder.
1994: Report #7	Jesuits learn of Fr. McGuire's abuse of another child in the 1960s at Loyola.
1995:	Jesuits tell Fr. McGuire not to travel overnight or be alone with anyone under the age of 21. Again, the public is not told of these "restrictions."
1998:	Jesuits allow Fr. McGuire to continue working.
2001:	Jesuits tell Fr. McGuire not to travel overnight or be alone with anyone under the age of 30.
2008:	Fr. McGuire is defrocked.
