



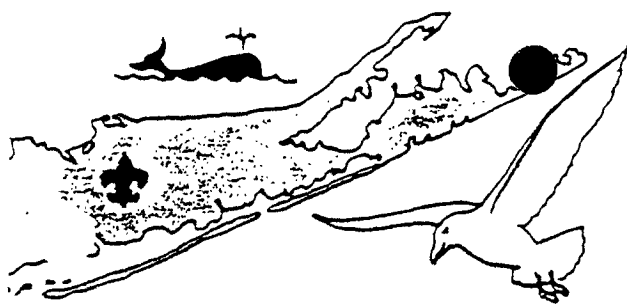

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a council review committee, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

own custody.

The indictment, in part, accuses both men of incidents of "deviate sexual behavior" involving two different teenagers in August, 1986, and April, 1987. In the indictment, Alletto is charged with one count of second-degree sodomy, three counts of third-degree sodomy and one count of sexual abuse. Maniscalco is charged with one count of second-degree sodomy, three counts of third-degree sodomy, one count of third-degree sexual abuse and one count of endangering the welfare of a child.

Thirteen of Alletto's 16 years as a Suffolk police officer were as coordinator of the First Precinct's Explorer Scout Post. Maniscalco is listed as a registered scout leader, according to the Suffolk County Council of the Boy Scouts of America.

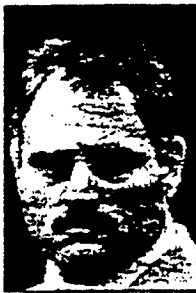
Alletto resigned from the department in June. His attorney, P. Kevin Brosnahan, said he did not know what the relationship was between the two men. Maniscalco's attorney, Philip Murphy, could not be reached for comment.

Jack Gibson, general foreman for Newsday's transportation department, said Maniscalco has been on administrative leave for the last seven months. He described Maniscalco as a good employee with no history of disciplinary problems.

## 2 Plead Innocent In Scout Sex Case

As a former Suffolk County police officer pleaded innocent yesterday to charges that he sodomized two members of a police-sponsored Boy Scout Explorer Post, it was disclosed that a second man has been indicted on sodomy and sexual abuse charges in the case.



Alletto

Gerald Alletto, 37, of 28 Charter Ave., Dix Hills, a Suffolk officer for 16 years, entered the innocent plea to the charges of sodomy and sex abuse filed by a Suffolk grand jury at arraignment at Suffolk County Court in Riverhead. County Court Judge Harvey Sherman continued Alletto free on the \$2,000 bail he had posted in July, when he was arrested on the sex charges.

During the arraignment, it was disclosed that an indictment included charges against Leonard Maniscalco, 26, of [redacted] West Babylon. Maniscalco, a Newsday truck driver, pleaded innocent to sodomy and sex abuse charges before Sherman on Wednesday and was ordered released in his
