Yesterday, I spoke via telephone with concerning a very unfortunate incident at the Boy Scout Camp.
said he would mention the incident to you for immediate action. I
would like to reconfirm this with my own personal letter. Since we
feel it is better for the boy to remain anonymous, I have taken it into m
own hand to register the complaint instead of his Father.

During a conversation which the boy's Father was having with the youngster concerning the facts of life, the boy revealed that at camp last week, the scout leader who was in charge of his group, someone by the name of Michael O'Hara, invited the youngster to his quarters one evening. He told the boy that he was conducting a study and then proceeded to show the boy copies of "playboy" Magazine, asking him what he thought of it. Then he proceeded to touch the boy impurely and invited the boy to do the same to him. The boy was so stunned that he didn't quite know what to do. He declined the leaders suggestion and left the quarters of this man. Mr. O'Hara impressed upon him the need for secrecy concerning this happening.

This incident happened once, and will certainly happen again unless this man is taken out of his scouting capacity. Who knows how many times this has happened before and how many youngsters, being frightened about what happened and not knowing how to tell another adult about it due to the shame, etc. connected with it, have been badly influenced by this man.

I know that you will, act accordingly in this matter to protect our youth. If there is anything that I can do to help you please do not hesitate to call on me. I feel that it would be best for the youngster concerned if this were not brought to his attention again by asking him any more questions.
