Two Men Convicted in Acts Will Six Teenage Boys

NEW YORK (UPI) — A former Boy Scout leader who plied low-income youths with drugs and all cohol to get them to person sex acts has been convicted of 25 counts of sodomy for abusing six teenage boys, including at deaf mute.

It took the jury of six, women and six men in state Supreme Court in Manhattan just five hours to reach a guilty verdict against Michael Olaskowitz, 40, an office manager for the Board of Education.

Also convicted in the case was Hilton Eldredge, 50, a driver for a cheese cake company, who was found guilty of 58 counts of sodomy as well as conspinacy.






