



Edward Pipala

In 1977, the Archdiocese of New York learned that Fr. Edward Pipala was sexually abusing children. In 1992, Fr. Pipala was sent to St. Luke Institute, a psychiatric hospital in Silver Springs, Maryland.

In 1993, he pleaded guilty and was convicted of sodomy and sex abuse and served seven years in prison. He was released in 2000 and laicized that same year. As of 2009, Fr. Pipala was a registered sex offender in New York.

Fr. Edward Pipala is alleged to have sexually abused as many as 50 boys at several parishes in the Archdiocese of New York.
